

text2pdf [options] [filename]

text2pdf makes a 7-bit clean PDF file (version 1.1) from any input file. It reads from standard input or a named file, and writes the PDF file to standard output.

There are various options as follows:

- h show this message
- f<font> use PostScript <font> (must be in standard 14, default: Courier)
  
- I use ISOLatin1Encoding
- s<size> use font at given pointsize (default 10)
- v<dist> use given line spacing (default 12 points)
- l<lines> lines per page (default 60, determined automatically if unspecified)
- c<chars> maximum characters per line (default 80)
- t<spaces> spaces per tab character (default 8)
- F ignore formfeed characters (^L)
- A4 use A4 paper (default Letter)
- A3 use A3 paper (default Letter)
- x<width> independent paper width in points
- y<height> independent paper height in points
- 2 format in 2 columns
- L landscape mode

Note that where one variable is implied by two options, the second option takes precedence for that variable. (e.g. -A4 -y500)  
In landscape mode, page width and height are simply swapped over before formatting, no matter how or when they were defined.
