

## Bye-laws

1. A list of Members shall be made at the commencement of the season and shall be hung in a conspicuous place in the Boathouse.
2. A copy of the Club Rules shall be exhibited in the Boathouse and it shall be the duty of each Member to acquaint themselves with the contents.
3. No boat shall remain away from the Boathouse moorings overnight without the permission of the Captain or a Vice-Captain.
4. All boats must start away and land at the landing place in an upstream direction.
5. All members of the Club shall adhere to the Club's Water Safety Policy at all times.
6. All Members landing from Boats shall assist in properly housing or mooring such boats and in placing the oars and other gear in their proper places. The Member pulling stroke oar shall be considered Captain of the boat and the other members of the crew shall be under their direction.
7. Any Member engaging to row in a Club crew and failing to do so, for any cause which the Committee deems insufficiently important, shall pay the entrance fee of the crew in which they should have rowed. They shall be deprived of their privileges in the Club until such fee is paid.
8. No animals are allowed in the Club dressing room.
9. Officers and Members of the Committee only are allowed keys to the Boathouse, but in special circumstances the Committee may give permission to Ordinary Members to have keys.
10. Damage done to or any loss of any property of the Club (including Club equipment of any description) by a Member or friend introduced by them shall be repaired and/or replaced under the direction of the Committee, and the Member shall be responsible for the cost incurred. Where proper care has been used by the Member or friend the Committee may suspend the operation of this Bye-Law.
11. The control of boats shall be under the direction of the Captain or a Vice-Captain or, in their absence, a Member of the Committee.
12. All Members rowing in races shall wear regulation Club attire.
